Scope

Member Code of Conduct

- Members are expected to follow and promote the [Principles of the u3a Movement](#) at every opportunity.
- Members are expected to treat each other with dignity and respect at all times.
- Members must act in the best interests of Islington u3a and the u3a Movement, strive to uphold its reputation and not do anything which could bring their own, another u3a or the u3a Movement into disrepute or expose it to undue risk.
- Members are expected to use Islington u3a's resources responsibly and only for the purpose of furthering its stated charitable objects/purposes.
- Members are expected to reflect the current policies of Islington u3a, regardless of whether they conflict with their personal views.
- Members are expected to abide by Islington u3a's procedures and practices.
