

METHOD USING THE APPLICATION CAMO

Most Windows PCs do not have a built-in camera so it is not possible to use them for Zooming. External webcams can be bought but the installation of the (FREE) application "CAMO" will enable you to participate in Zoom U3A meetings without buying extra equipment. A lot of laptops do have a camera but, if not, these instructions will equally apply.

(Unfortunately, Camo was not available on Android phones, it is worth checking as this seems to have changed.)

It is possible to use Zoom on an iPhone alone but, as the screen is so small, it's an uncomfortable experience. The Camo method of using an iPhone with a PC/laptop makes it a much better experience. It also gives a much better quality picture than on plugin external webcams and saves the cost of purchasing one.

The Camo method requires the download of an App for your iPhone and a program on your PC/laptop. This sounds complicated, but here is step-by-step guidance.
