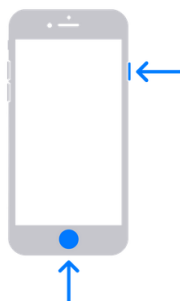


Screenshot with Touch I/D and Side Button

Press the side button and the Home button at the same time and then quickly release them.



After you take the screenshot, a thumbnail appears in the bottom left-hand corner of your screen. You can tap to open it and edit it or edit it later from where it is filed in your Photos.

Editing is described later in this document.

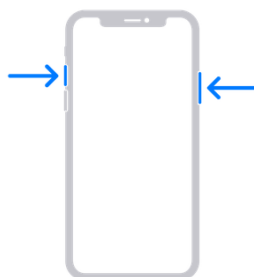
Screenshot with Touch i/d and Top Button, same on iPad

Screenshot with Face i/d

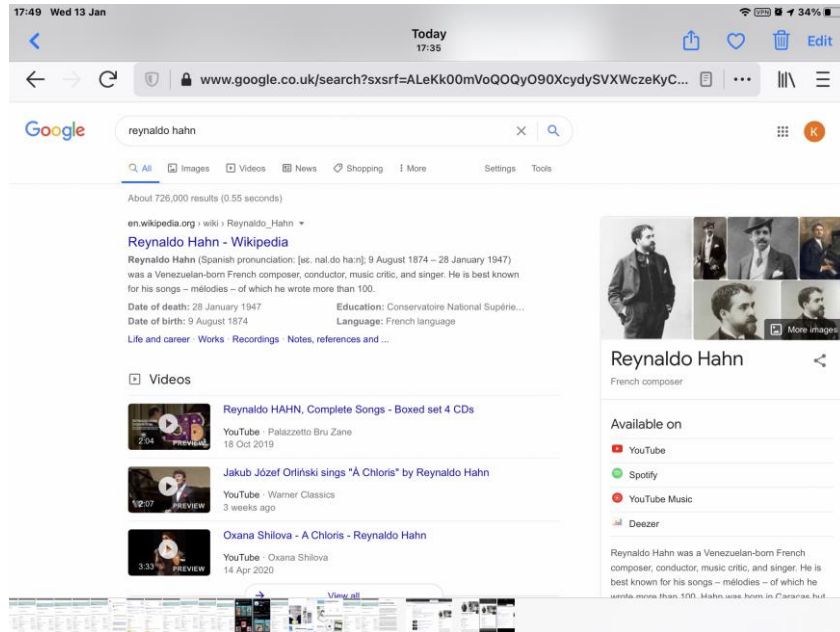
Press buttons as shown.



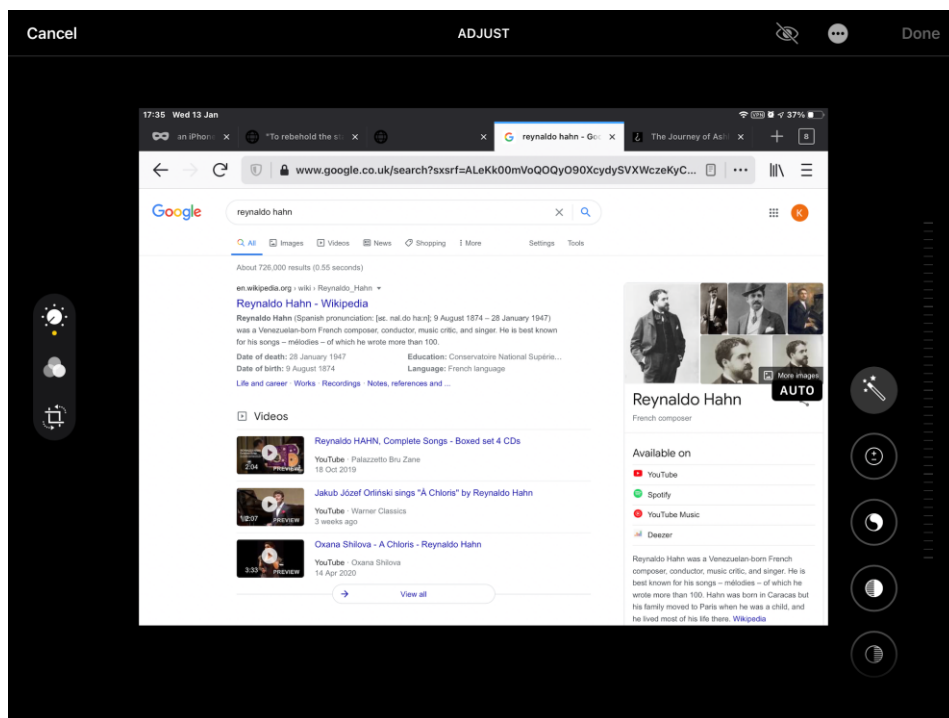
Editing Screenshots

Go to Photos, Albums and Screenshots.

Open the screenshot that you want to edit. Example from the web:



Click on "Edit" to get the editing screen



The most useful tool is the cropping tool (bottom tool on left-hand side).

Click on it to get this image where you can pull the corners of the picture to isolate a section that you might want to keep. You can experiment with other tools. When finished click "Done" and the edited picture is saved back to the Screenshot Album.
