

## Islington U3A Leisurely Walks Group

Walk/Distance	Whitechapel to Wapping – about 3 miles
Date/Time	Tuesday 18 June 2024
Meeting up and travel	Meet at 10.00 outside Highbury & Islington Station. We will take the 10.11 Overground to Whitechapel Station arriving at 10.24. If you plan to join the walk at Whitechapel please meet us outside the station at 10.30.
Route & Terrain	From Whitechapel Road we will make our way to St Dunstan & All Saints Church. We will then walk through Limehouse and join the Thames Path. After a short detour through King Edward Memorial Park we rejoin the Thames Path and follow it as much as possible to Wapping Station.
Potential hazards	No mud but some cobbled pavements along the way. Although there's a lift to take you part way down to the platform at Wapping Station there are some steep stairs to navigate.
Breaks/toilet	Coffee stop at the Yurt Café in Butchers Row There are toilets at the cafe.
Clothing/footwear	Comfortable walking shoes and waterproofs/umbrella if necessary.

	Leave Cafe	D3 to Wapping Station for anyone who wants to drop out
	Through Keeper Wharf to water	
	Detour along The Highway – enter King Edward 7 <sup>th</sup> Park Walk through park and rejoin Thames Path.	
	At cnr Garnet Street turn left, over bridge and take left to Thames Path. Come out by Prospect of Whitby.	
	Continue walking along until we get to Chinese Restaurant	
	Through alleyway to Thames Path – walk along until we come to exit	
	Arrive Wapping Station
